The calculation of your HOPE SCHOLARSHIP CUMULATIVE GPA is determined by the following:

- All college credit hours attempted after high school graduation (hours attempted while seeking a degree) at all postsecondary institutions the student attended and their corresponding grades must be included in the HOPE cumulative GPA, regardless of what hours are accepted or not accepted by the institution the student is currently attending or if the course was repeated, or if the course was "forgiven" by the institution.
- Your HOPE Scholar eligibility will be determined once the grades are available for the quarter after you have attempted 45, 90 or 135 credit hours.
- You must have a 3.0 GPA or better to be eligible for HOPE Scholarship at the end of the 45, 90 or 135 attempted credit hours and other stated checkpoints as specified by the HOPE program.
